

## **Terms of Reference for a Facilitator to guide the County EWER Teams in Bungoma and Uasin Gishu Counties.**

### **1. Background**

RWPL is in the process of implementing an 8-month long project on a community driven early warning early response mechanism in Bungoma and Uasin Gishu counties. The process of developing material will involve high level consultation with the County Governing structures, national bodies such as NCIC and the local communities. The aim of this temporary assignment is to facilitate EWER workshops in each county whose input will be key to creating a robust County EWER Hub critical in prevention, management and resolution of conflicts.

#### **Objective:**

The Facilitator (Consultant) will facilitate two workshops in Uasin Gishu and Bungoma counties involving the county stakeholders that work on conflict peace and security, they will be from various sectors of security organs, CSOs, legal, cultural and in some cases representatives of national bodies such as the NCIC and National Youth Council. These engagements will aim to drive dialogue and conversation on peace and security in the two counties and to assist in the setup of inclusive and robust EWER structures within the two counties.

#### **Scope of Work**

Facilitate at least two workshops. The workshops must be participatory to prove critical review by the participants.

Develop workshop materials and methodologies.

Facilitate workshop participants to create a forum for discussion on how to link various peace actors on early warning early response Hub.

Identify opportunities for intervention aligning to the national pursuit of social cohesion, peace and security for all.

Identify capabilities and priorities to inform the creation of the EWER Hub and develop and key guidelines of operation. Engage RWPL during and after the workshops.

Write a clear and concise EWER training report

Support evaluation of the EWER workshops and EWER implementation process

**Timeframe:** The duration of the consultancy will be 10 days

**Deliverables**

- Facilitate 2 workshops
- Prepare Post session Reports
- Develop Working Guidelines for the County Hub EWER Teams

**Expertise Required:**

1. Demonstrate experience in facilitation of such EWER workshops with references
2. Knowledge and experience in working in either or both of the two counties
3. Deep knowledge on Conflict Peace Security both at national and county level and how it interacts with development issues.
4. Familiarity with the political terrain of Bungoma and Uasin Gishu.
5. Degree holder in Social studies, Peace or Development Studies. An Advanced Degree is a plus.
6. Fluency in English, Kiswahili and local language is a plus.
